# UNSW Pathway Scholarships 2021

Scholarships are now available for UNSW Foundation Studies and Diploma programs commencing in 2021. These scholarships have been designed to provide extra support to students wishing to start their journey to UNSW Sydney.

### Important information

- To be eligible, students must have an unconditional offer, or a conditional offer which is packaged with an English course for Diplomas or Foundation Studies.
- Scholarships are in the form of a fee waiver and are not combinable with any other scholarship or fee waiver in respect of the program.
- Scholarships are not transferable to any other intake or to another applicant.
- Foundation Studies applicants must accept their program offer and scholarship offer as well as make payment of the remaining part 1 tuition fees within two (2) weeks of receiving their scholarship offer.
- Diploma applicants must accept their program offer and scholarship offer, as well as making full payment of their deposit within two (2) weeks of receiving their scholarship offer. The scholarship will be applied equally to the three (3) terms of the Diploma in the form of fee remission to future tuition fee instalments.
- The scheme will commence on 28 July 2020; these scholarships will be available until the scholarship quotas are reached as offers are limited.
- Students must not be already enrolled in their Diploma or Foundation Studies program.
- Students who successfully complete their UNSW Global Program may be eligible for other scholarships at UNSW. For more information visit unsw.global/scholarships
- Scholarship eligibility criteria are set out based on academic merits and a student's performance in subjects relevant to their chosen stream will also be considered.
